How Gospel of Jesus Christ came to India

- Saint Thomas in AD 52 came and was martyred in AD 72 and Indian church established
- Roman Catholic Missionaries during 15th Century from Europe
- Protestant Missionaries during 18th Century onwards came from US, Europe & Australia.
- Now, we as groups are spreading the glory starting 20th Century
- Yet, only 800 people groups reached out of 4635.

- Focusing on receptive people groups, yet unreached.
- To raise more native missionaries to reach their own people groups.
- Planting indigenous Churches.
- Training indigenous leadership for the Church and society.
- Holistic development of the believers.

- To add at least 2000 converts, 40 Congregations, Add 20 more fields, & add 25 Missionaries every Year
- Find 25 more permanent sponsor groups every Year
- Plan to add at least 25 more Church buildings
- Plan to have a training centre in Gujarat, Jharkhand, and Maharashtra to train in their native languages.
- Construct Children's Homes in Jharkhand - 1, Maharashtra -2, & Gujarat -2
- Add 200 more sponsors for the tribal children support
- To work in partnership with other mission agencies to complete the task.

In the 1950s, there was great revival in South Tamilnadu that resulted in many coming forward to present the Gospel to the unreached people who constitute about 97% of the Indian population.

Mr P Samuel attached to the South India Bible Seminary, Bangarapet, challenged the people towards this, which resulted in many going as Missionaries, Missionary Pastors, and Missionaries in secular profession.

Rev Dr Samuel Devadason, who worked all his life as a Missionary Trainer, founded the "Gospel Partners Movement" on 03.10.1999 in the well known CSI Webb Memorial Church in Madurai, South India. The Gospel flame which he lit with His guidance continues to spread far and wide and no one can quench it.

At present we have established 20 Mission Fields in 5 States - Punjab, Haryana, Jharkhand, Maharashtra and Gujarat & in Dadra Nagar Haveli, a Union Territory. Missionary work is carried out by 130 Missionaries and 19 Project Staff. Through their labours more than 10,000 people have been baptized.

Children are the hope of the future. Children in these areas have no access to Schools, for want of road, public transport and money to provide education. We have children in 4 Children Homes, where 130 children are provided with food, shelter, clothing and education. These children share the Bible verses and teachings to their parents and neighbours when they go home for vacation. This is Evangelism through and by the children. We propose to provide children with graduate and post-graduate education in future.
